

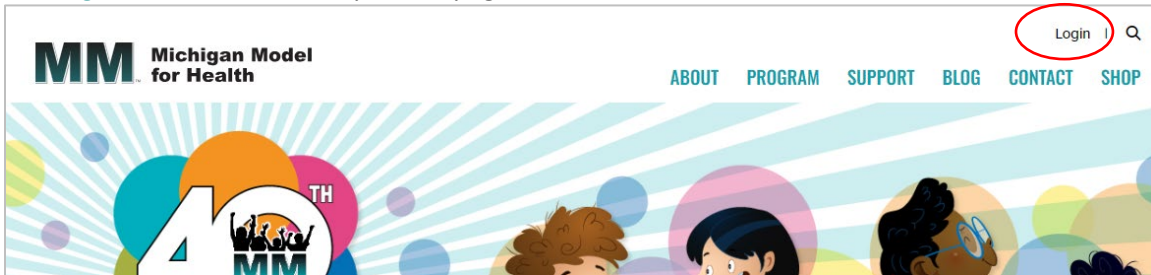


Michigan Model for Health™ How to Log into the MMH Website

This document provides instructions on how to log into the Michigan Model For Health™ website (MMH Portal) area for Teachers, Educators, and Digital License Managers.

Portal Login Instructions:

- 1) Go to <https://michiganmodelforhealth.org>
- 2) Click the **Login** menu link at the top of the page.



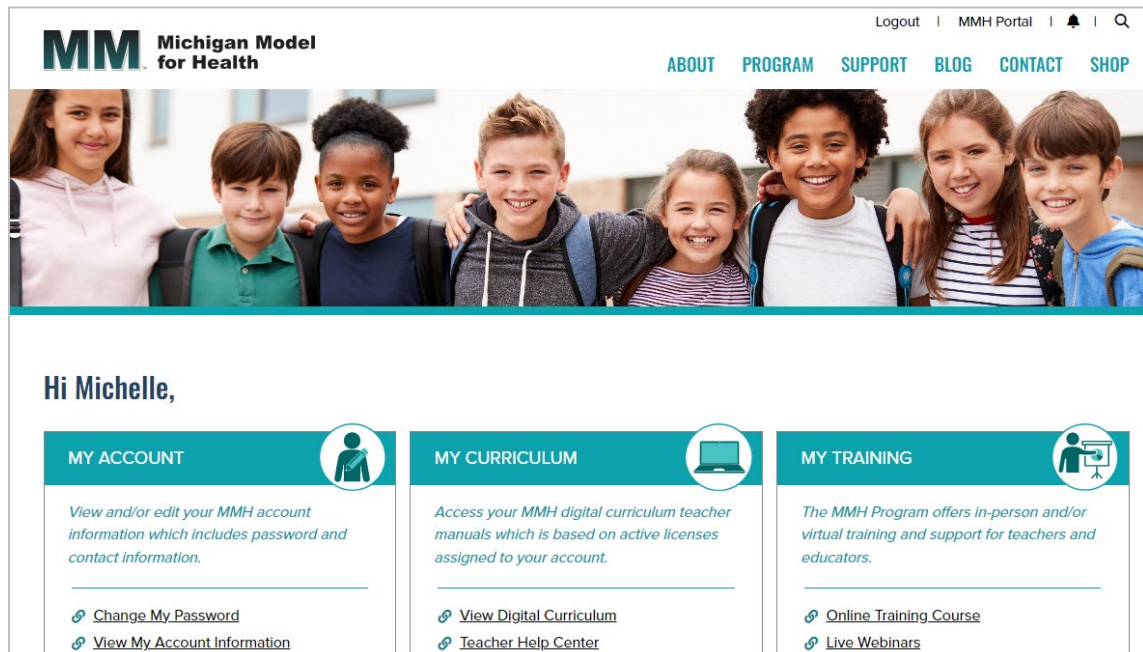
- 3) Enter your **Username** and **Password** and then click the **Log In** button.

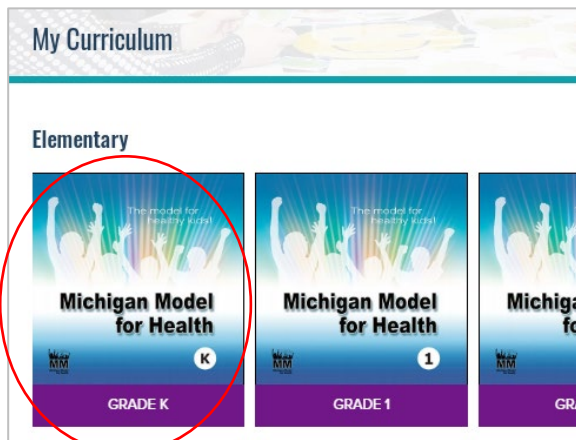
Access to Digital Curriculum *(Educators With Active Licenses Only)*

Access to Digital License Management System (Digital License Managers Only)

To access the MMH Digital License Management System, click the [Manage Curriculum Licenses](#) link from the **MMH Portal** page within the **My Licenses** box. From the **License Management** page, conduct a search to find a license, run reports and/or assign digital licenses to teachers.

License Managers can click the [Manage Teacher Accounts](#) link to view, add or edit teacher accounts.

Changing a Password:

To change your password while logged into the MMH website, click on the [Change My Password](#) link from the **MMH Portal** page within the **My Account** box. From the **My Account** page, enter your [Current Password](#) and then enter your new password in the [New Password](#) and [Confirm New Password](#) fields. Click the [Change Password](#) button.
